Accountants and financial professionals benefit the most from acquiring the CMA credential and can expect improvement in their business fields.

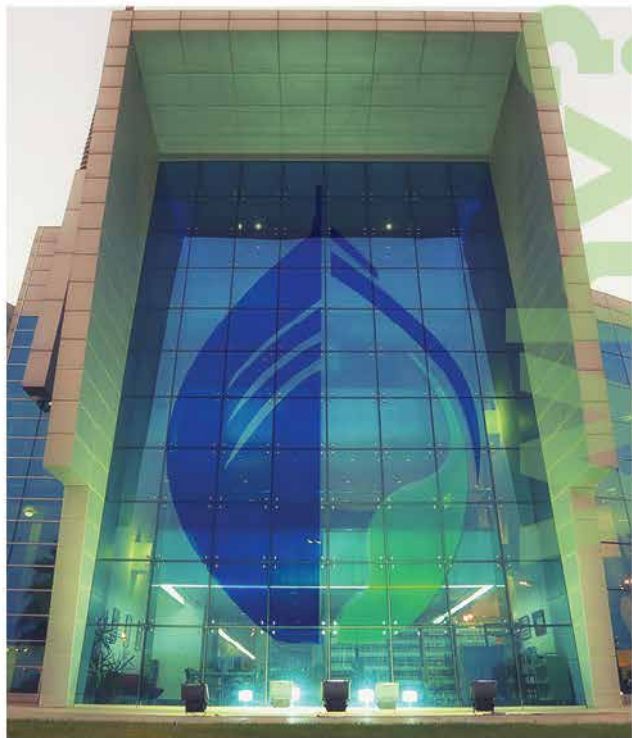
## What is important about the CMA program?

There are currently 3 testing windows each year for the CMA exam:

- January and February
- May and June
- September and October

## Exam Structure

CMA exam is organized into two parts, which can be taken in any order. Each exam part is four hours in length and includes 100 multiple-choice questions and two 30-minutes essay questions.
