Benefits of becoming CPA Certified

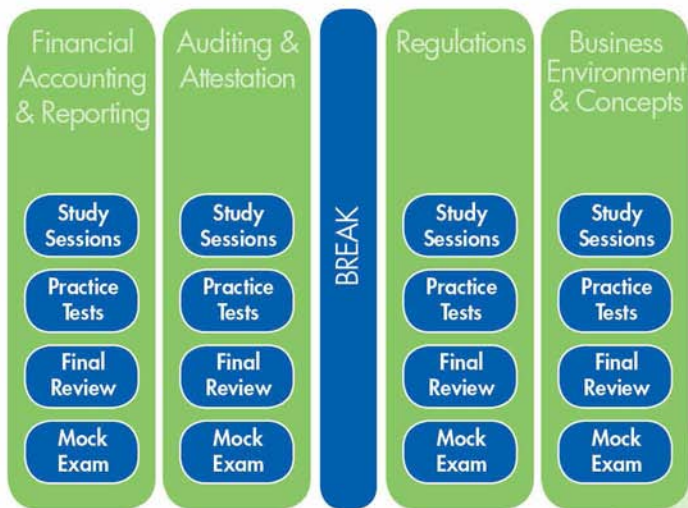
- **Prestige and Respect:** Respected and admired by their peers, clients and society, CPAs are often viewed as an elite group of professionals.

REG	3 Hours	3 MCQ sections consisting of a total of 90 questions & 1 section with 7 Task Based Simulations (TBS)
BEC	3 Hours	3 MCQ sections consisting of a total of 72 questions & 1 section with 6 Task Based Simulations (TBS)
